CCHS A Level Results Day 2020 – SchoolPost dated 7th July 2020

You will understand that in the current situation we will need to make some changes to our normal procedures for A level results day on Thursday 13th August 2020. This letter outlines the procedures we will follow to ensure that all students are properly supported both on this important day and in the days following.

We would like to remind all students and parents that in submitting grades to the examination boards, our School has assiduously followed the guidance issued by the Department for Education and Ofqual. We have taken into consideration a wide range of data on the performance of individual students and on past outcomes per subject at A level and used detailed data modelling and the expertise of our staff to generate the grades we submitted in June. We are confident that the data we have submitted is both fair and rigorous and does the very best possible for all of our students. The possibility remains that our submitted data will be adjusted by the examination boards. Please see the accompanying document, 'Centre Assessed Grades – Summer 2020' for detailed information on the process that we followed.

We will be issuing results electronically at 8.00am, with details on how to access this being provided to you in a separate communication. This early release will ensure that those students who need it have the best possible chance to access support in school and the UCAS Clearing service.

Senior staff will then be available in school throughout Thursday 13th and Friday 14th (and on days following if required) to offer a variety of support to students. Students and their parents will be able to book appointments via the School website to discuss any issues of concern. Mrs Hopkins and Dr Palmer will be available to support students over UCAS options and the Clearing process and other staff will be on hand to offer help on the Autumn Term exam series, the appeals process and for any other matter that students or their parents wish to raise. Further details on the appeals process and Autumn Term exam series will be sent in due course.
