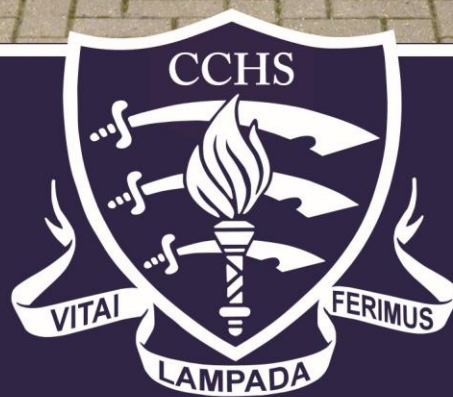

One of our Sixth Form students represented Great Britain at the International Biology Olympiad in Hungary last year, achieving the highest score of anyone in the UK team.

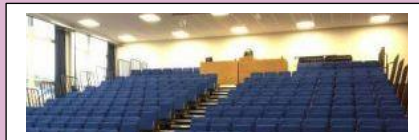
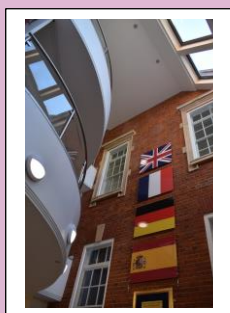


CCHS originally opened its doors to students in 1907 and has grown significantly in student number since then.
