What we can offer to support your daughter's application to CCHS.

<u>This information is relevant to children in receipt of the pupil premium</u> <u>Grant.</u>

We offer up to 30 extra places for girls in receipt of the pupil premium, who live at a permanent home address within the 12.5 miles (click <u>here</u> to check your address).

Questions & Answers

1. How do I register my daughter to sit the CCHS Entrance Test?

For entry to Year 7 in September 2022. Click here

2. I do not have access to a computer, can I register my daughter on a paper copy?

3. When is the deadline?

Registration for the CCHS Entrance Test will be open from 9am Friday 30 April and the deadline is <u>4pm Wednesday 23 June 2021.</u>

4. <u>What if I need help to complete the registration for my daughter to sit the entrance test?</u>

Supported registration, with fully trained CCHS staff, are available for you at our school. Please do contact us on Tel: 01245 352592 or email: <u>admissions@cchs.essex.sch.uk</u> and we will be happy to support you.

5. <u>Can I come and look around the School with my daughter?</u>

We are pleased to offer a virtual event, available to view on our school web-site, from 30 April 2021. You will be able to view the school, see staff and pupils, from the safety of your home. The current COVID guidelines do not allow visits at this time.

6. How do I find out if <u>my daughter is eligible for the Pupil Premium Grant?</u>

If your daughter has received free school meals, at ANY time during the past 6 years, she will be eligible for the Pupil Premium Grant. If in doubt, please ask your primary school teacher.



7. How will my daughter be supported to gain a place at CCHS?

If you attend one of the following primary schools, we will offer virtual outreach work this year. Each Primary School will be provided with a booklet with information about Chelmsford County High School and appropriate resources.

Opportunities to support your daughter's journey towards the CCHS Entrance Test will also be available. We will offer familiarisation work to help your daughter access the CCHS Entrance Test.

8. When is the test?

The CCHS Entrance Test is on Saturday 11th September 2021 (right at the beginning of Year 6)

9. Does this cost any money?

No, all parts of the process are free and grammar schools are state schools and fully funded by the government. Your daughter will be informed of the time of the test and what to bring on the day of the test. A letter will be sent to you after registration has been completed.



10. <u>What kind of score will my daughter need to</u> <u>achieve in the test?</u>

A lower entrance test result is required to gain a place at CCHS for girls who are in receipt of the Pupil Premium and living at a permanent home address within the 12.5 mile priority area only. These girls will be placed at the top of the list, if their result in the CCHS Entrance Test falls in the top two bands of the entrance test results (this represents a significant uplift for your daughters)

11. <u>When will we get the results of the test?</u>

You will receive the test results in October 2021 and must apply to your home local authority by the deadline of 31st October 2021. The results letter will clearly show you whether your daughter has gained a score in the top two result bands.



12. What support can you offer my daughter if she joins CCHS?

Support is available to all of our students, but specifically for girls in receipt of the pupil premium the following are on offer: financial support with some school trips, including overseas curriculum-related trips; nearly new uniform sales with the CCHS Parents' Association; individual and small group extra tuition, if necessary; and financial support to learn a musical instrument. We also offer support with revision booklets and stationery and materials to support your daughter's learning.

Simmonds, our uniform supplier, have very generously agreed to provide a uniform starter pack for any girls who are in receipt of the pupil premium grant, at **no cost**, when they join the school in Year 7. This will include the following:

- CCHS jacket
- CCHS jumper
- 1 twin pack of CCHS blouses
- CCHS kilt
- CCHS hoodie

(Please note that this information is used discreetly and other children will not be aware of whether your daughter is in receipt of the pupil premium or currently on Free School Meals.)
