Entry Requirements (1)

- The offer of places is determined by GCSE score; places are offered after GCSE Results to internal students and then to external students in rank order of GCSE results.
- Details of this are in the Admissions Policy.
- Headlines:
 - All candidates are required to have reformed grade 6 or grade B or higher in GCSE/IGCSE English Language and Mathematics.
 - All candidates must achieve an average of at least 6.4375 over their best eight GCSE grades, including English Language and Mathematics.
 - **Subject specific requirements are detailed in the subjects booklet.**



Entry Requirements (2)

- How do I work out my average GCSE points score, using my best 8 grades? 6.4375 is required.

The Process...

- Internal students will fill out an Options Form – these will be made available shortly after half term.
- External applicants will fill out an Application Form – these will be made available shortly after half term.
- The deadline for external applications is 10th February; for internal students the deadline for the Options Form is 17th March.
- Induction Events will take place in the summer, Covid 19 permitting.
- All internal students have a place provided their GCSEs meet the entry requirements.
- External applicants are offered places on the basis of their GCSE results once they submit these to us.
