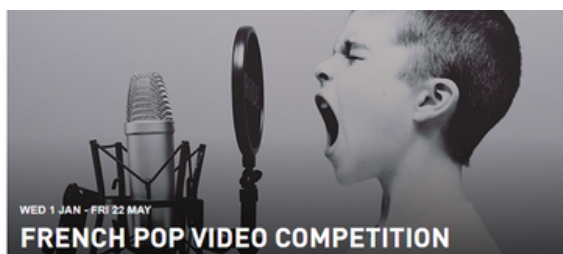

Prethika was delighted to represent CCHS as a winner – it was an incredibly proud moment for her.



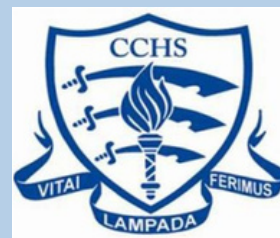

We would like to ask that you consider donating any CCHS school uniform that you no longer require, for the PA to sell at the termly Pre-loved Uniform sales.

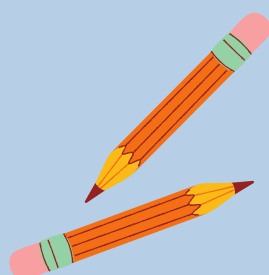
Clean uniform can be brought into school on the morning of Thursday 30th June during the Sixth Form Induction morning.
