Pay for your items in the usual way and the books will be delivered to CCHS

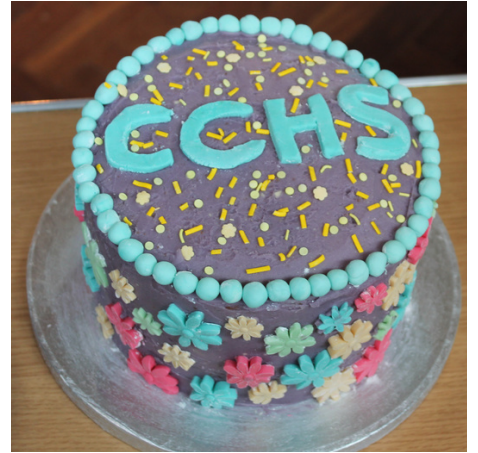
When the books arrive a name plate will be added to the book to recognise your generous gift to the school.

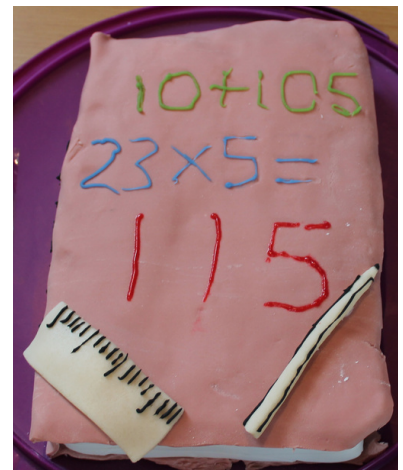
