GREATER CULTURAL COMPETENCY

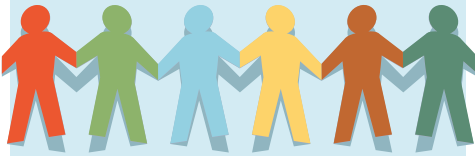
Respect cultural differences

Value giving back

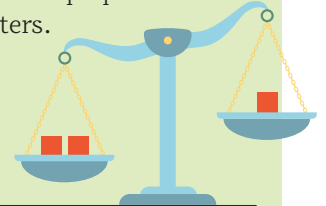
They are frequently active in volunteer work.
