

Remote Learning Agreement to ensure the Safeguarding of both Staff and Students Chelmsford County High School for Girls

Dear Parents,

In the event that we may need to activate remote schooling we have drawn up a new, Remote Learning Agreement to ensure the safety of all members of the school community. This document sits alongside our Home School Agreement and the established CCHS Behaviour Policy and, as is usual, impeccable standards of behaviour are expected at all times.

We ask that you read this with your daughter.

The Basic Principles

This additional agreement aims to:

- identify acceptable and unacceptable behaviour.
- encourage cooperation, honesty, fairness and respect.
- create a learning environment where your self-esteem, self-respect and self-confidence will grow.
- encourage you to take responsibility for your own behaviour.
- help resolve conflicts and make it clear what will happen if you decide not to follow the agreement.

Acceptable and Non-Acceptable behaviour:

You should:

- cooperate with others.
- be friendly
- be patient and positive.
- listen to others
- be helpful
- have good manners
- treat everyone with respect.
- take responsibility for your own behaviour.
- talk to your Year Leader about anything that worries or concerns you.
- follow this agreement and the school's behaviour policy.

- meet deadlines set by your teachers.
- join in and enjoy learning!

You should not:

- be disrespectful to anyone else.
- record all or any parts of the lesson.
- take any photographs of your teachers or other students.
- write anything you would not say to a peer or teacher on an online platform.

If I do not follow this agreement I understand that there will be consequences in line with the <u>CCHS Behaviour Policy.</u>
