Year 13 rota – subject to change.

LESSON 1 & 2 - Completion of UCAS

Students will use this time to finish their UCAS applications with the support of the UCAS coordinator and form tutors.

LESSON 3 & 4 - Independent Living

These lessons cover the basics of living independently in preparation for moving away from home for the first time. Topics include:

- 1. First aid
- 2. Drink safety
- 3. Basic finances
- 4. Cooking for yourself and budgeting
- 5. Online safety

LESSON 5 - Interview Skills

Students will work through a series of questions to prepare for university interviews. The class will also discuss how to present themselves effectively in an interview setting.

LESSON 6 - 9 - Electives

Students will choose three lessons from a diverse range of topics, including:

- Crafting
- Relaxation & yoga
- How to beatbox
- Greek literature
- Science in action
- DIY skills
- Singing in a gospel choir
- How to solve a Rubik's cube

LESSON 10 – Sixth Form Fayre

Students will run a stall in their prefect role, speaking with Year 11 students about their work and discussing course layouts.

LESSON 11 & 12 - Sex Education

A more in-depth discussion on topics including contraception, pregnancy, miscarriage, abortion, and menopause, building on previous KS4 knowledge.

LESSON 13 & 14 - Society and Culture

Discussions on modern social issues, including:

- Call-out culture and its impact on society
- The influence of the internet
- Culture wars and cultural appropriation, linked to current news stories

LESSON 15 - WizeUp Financial Education

Students will choose a session focused on budgeting, flat-sharing, savings, or investments.

LESSON 16 - Festivals and Clubbing

Students will explore the positive and negative aspects of festivals and clubbing in preparation for summer.
