16-19 Bursary Guidance and Application

Students aged between 16 and 19 who may be facing financial hardship whilst in full-time education can apply to receive bursary funding.

To be eligible to receive a bursary you must:

- Be aged 16 or over but under 19 on 31 August 2025; **and**
- Have the legal right to be a resident in the United Kingdom at the start of your study programme.
- Have a household income of £48,000 or less; **or**
- Be in care / a care leaver; **or**
- Be in receipt of Income Support or Universal credit in your own name; **or**
- Be in receipt of Disability Living Allowance or Personal Independence Payments, as well as Employment Support Allowance or Universal Credit in your own name.

When completing the below application form, please fill in all sections and provide evidence as requested. The awards will be dependent on adherence to the Sixth Form Contract, excellent attendance (a minimum attendance of 90% will be expected, with all absence properly authorised), as well as excellent application and conduct.

All students are welcome to apply for a bursary. Please submit this application form to Mrs Gansbuehler in the Finance Office, or email it to cgansbuehler@cchs.co.uk by Friday 19th September 2025. Please note that this is not a final deadline for applications for the year, and we encourage students to apply at any point during their time in the Sixth Form, if financial support is needed.

All students are required to complete a statement of need (what you need the money for and how much), which is used to assess the funding limit that you will be awarded. It is recognised that expenses may occur during the year that you are not aware of at the time of application. These will be considered as they arise depending on funding availability.

Once applications have been assessed, in line with the eligibility criteria, the Finance Team will contact you to let you know if your application has been successful and provide further information. All applications will be dealt with in the strictest confidence.

Discretionary Bursary

If your total household income is below £48,000, you may be entitled to support with costs such as course related equipment or activities (including school trips), food during the school day, travel to and from school, school uniform (blazer) and costs of attending university interviews / open days. The school has the discretion to review / approve applications where the total household income exceeds the threshold by up to 5%.

Defined Vulnerable Groups Bursary

If you are in one of the following groups you will be entitled to a bursary, of up to £1,200, provided that you can demonstrate need for the money:

- Student living in care or a care leaver; or



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- Student receiving Income Support or Universal Credit, because they are financially supporting themselves and someone who is dependent on them and living with them, such as a child or partner; or
- Student receiving Disability Living Allowance or Personal Independence Payments in their own right, as well as Employment and Support Allowance or Universal Credit.
