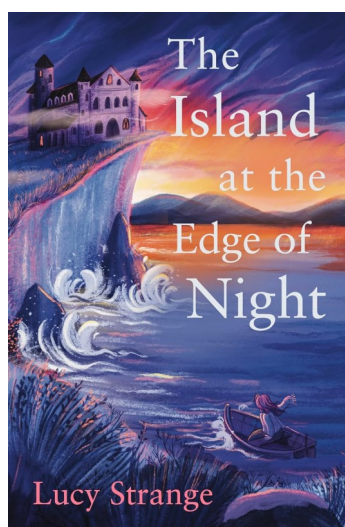
Michelle has written books like the 'Pinch of Magic' series and the 13 Treasures trilogy.

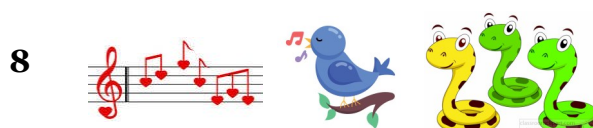
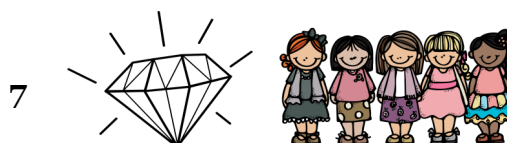
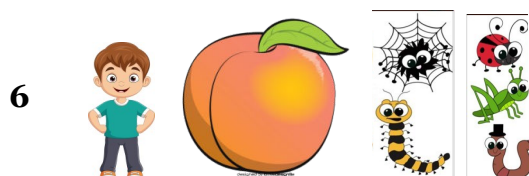
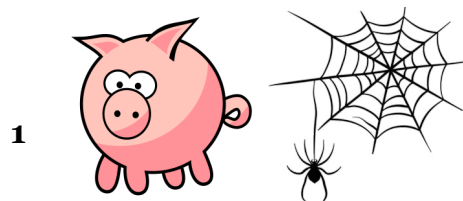
SUBJECT FOCUS: SPANISH
