

# House Debate YR12 & YR13



## YR12 Houses of Parliament Trip

In December, the year 12 politics students were fortunate enough to go on a trip to the houses of Parliament and have a guided tour and workshop afterwards. Our tour began by making our way to Westminster hall where we were shown many special features including a glass installation called New Dawn which celebrates women's suffrage. From there we were able to enter the House of Commons where our guide explained the workings of the house and helped us visualise what we had been learning in class. This was followed by us not only visiting the House of Lord's but getting the rare opportunity to witness a debate happening on Assisted Dying Bill which was a fascinating experience.

After our tour, we partook in a workshop where we were split into groups and ran our own election campaign and then presented them to our peers. Our group won the mock election with an over 50% majority with some of our key policies being related to Carbon Offsetting and investing in education investment schemes. We also met with one of the staff members of Chelmsford's MP and he answered our questions about a career in politics and offered to take our suggestions forward to Mrs Goldman.

It was such a valuable trip to go on and the future y12's should be excited for it in the following years.
