

**SEND meeting update (HP/CFA/SW)
Autumn Term 2024-2025**

Heidi and Claire have shared termly update to the SSM Committee.

There are 52 students on the SEND register presenting a range of conditions (please see SEND Provision at CCHS document: Overview September 2024), 4 with EHCP in Y12/Y13 and 48 on K code. Year 7 has 7 students with SEND (2 hearing/visual impairment)

This term we discussed relationship building strategies with parents of students with SEND, in particular around an ongoing work and support for two students in Year 11. Provision of dedicated, high quality tailored support by Heidi, Claire, Year Leads and SLT is evident. Appropriate help is sought from external agencies such as Hatfield Wick Education (supported by the ECC) and Educational Psychologists. We discussed successes in student engagement in learning (one-to-one support) and as well as attendance following interventions and support provided.

HP/CFA are developing and sharing dedicated short briefing notes for teaching faculty to inform curriculum adjustments for students with SEND, this is proving successful.

Staff training: internal training will focus on supporting students with dyslexia/dyslexic traits. ECC will offer a refresher training on understanding Autism Spectrum Disorder (note: there are currently 23 students across the year groups who present autistic spectrum condition or traits).

HP's NPQ SENDCo training has commenced in October 2024 and will continue over a period of 18 months.

SW thanked HP and CFA for all the hard work, dedication, and commitment to supporting staff, students with SEND and their families.
