

PA REPORT – October 2018

The PA have applied for Co-op funding, they had to specify a project, so they said it was to enhance the outside space, so if successful could be used for almost anything.

Fund raising was discussed.

The Christmas Fayre is being planned, as is the Christmas Draw.

A disco is being planned for December, although the last one had to be cancelled due to lack of interest.

Second hand uniform sales are being planned.

There will be a textile collection in November, this is a very easy fundraiser and everyone is urged to bring in their unwanted clothes.

A donut day is being planned in December together with Christmas Jumper Day.

With so many fundraisers being planned I have no doubt that the PA will again raise a significant amount of money for the school.

The PA continue to supply refreshments for Parents Evenings.

Their AGM is being held in the Library on 18th October.
