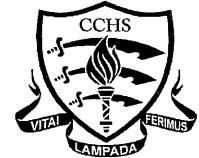


Governor Visit Report Form

Focus of Visit:	Review status of the new build project planning.
Lessons/Areas visited:	Toured Bancroft external and site of new build area Sat in on ½ English lesson of Year 10 being taught by Matthew Carter
Summary of activities undertaken: (eg observing classes, talking to staff and pupils, looking at resources) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Walked round Bancroft and swimming pool area for new build and sports centre- Spent around an hour with Melissa Mulgrew looking into the new build project- Sat in on year 10 English class taught by Matthew Carter	
General Comments: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Covered a number of the technical challenges of demolishing Bancroft in a set budget, incl reviewing existing cracking to swimming pool- Reviewed where school is in planning the demolition of Bancroft and the new build including decisions around swimming pool and access from Chelmer Valley Road. School is working very hard to keep up and be on top of the preferred timescale to demolish Bancroft this summer 2019 and have new build ready for 2021.- Yr 10 English lesson was working on Shakespeare's Much Ado About Nothing. The lesson felt excellent. Matthew Carter challenged and prompted and handled the discussion with the girls very well. The material was among desires for emotional and physical relationships among the protagonists in the play and I thought Matthew handled it superbly well and I would have thought to great educational benefit for the girls.	
Summary of what was learned: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- School has to continue to run hard to get the Bancroft demolition and new build planning and activities fully into control for the timescale desired. With the confluence of the funding arriving much later than we would have liked then coinciding with changes in personnel in the school and Governors school has a way to go to get the project comfortably under control, in my view, and to include timing of necessary decisions around the swimming pool and the possible opportunity of an entrance onto Chelmer Valley Road which would have very many benefits for the school and transport and road systems around the school.
