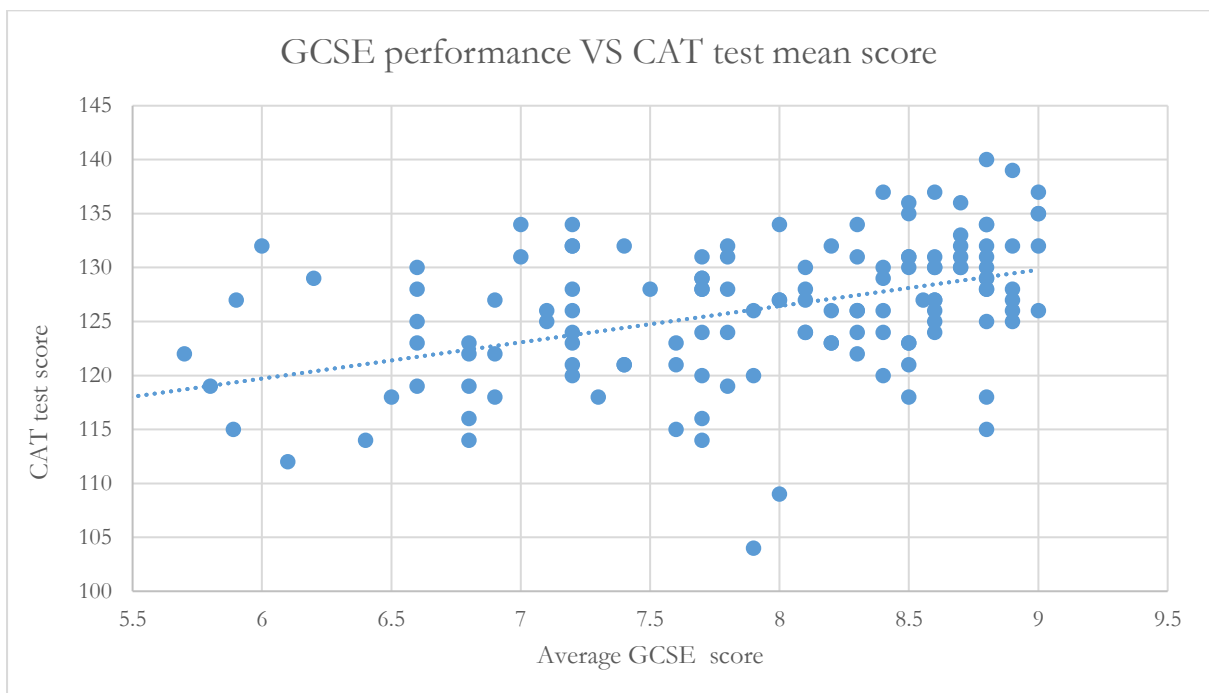
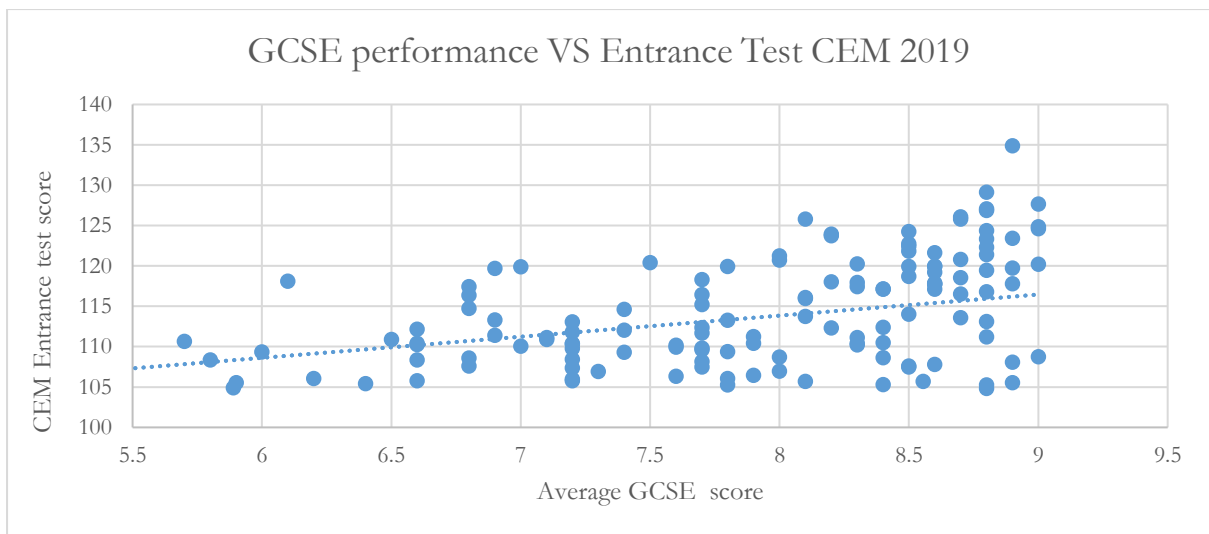




Analysis of GCSE results against CAT, CEM and Midyis November 2024

Executive Summary

- Analysis of Midyis, CAT and CEM indicate a positive correlation (significant though due to large cohort size) between Average GCSE and the external data held for these students.
- The correlation for CEM, CAT and MIDYIS are very similar with Spearmans rank correlation coefficients of 0.48, 0.43 and 0.56 respectively, these figures are in somewhat higher than correlations observed in previous years.
- This analysis continues to support the use of external data for tracking student attainment.
