As a cohort, there has been a 1.7% uplift in students' achieving Grades 7-9 since their last TA cycle (TA3 in Year 10). When making a comparison between this year's data and the previous year's, we see a small downshift in headline figure (1.5%). Six subjects have headline figure of (Grade 7-9) above 90%. These are: English Literature, English Language, Biology, Chemistry, Music and RS. Two subjects have headline figures below 80% (Computing and French). Both subjects are offering a comprehensive range of additional support inside and outside of lessons. Both departments are also being supported by their SLT line manager to improve outcomes. Based on last year's cohort we see higher TA1 outcomes in the following subjects: Maths, English Language, Chemistry, Geography, Music, Physics and RS.
