This data demonstrates an upward trend in the headline figure. Students in this cohort have made an average percentage increase of 4.7% since the last TA cycle (TA3 in Year 12); this is also a 1.5% uplift on last year's cohort at TA1. All but three departments (Art, Physics and Spanish) have headline figures of over 80% A\*-B, with Theatre Studies, PE and RS showing a headline of 100% A\*-B for all students. Economics, English Literature, French and Government and Politics also show strong outcomes with headline figures of above 95% A\*-B. The headline figures in Art and Spanish particularly should be considered in the context of the numbers taking the subject; the number of students not in the A\*-B framework are: 2x in Spanish and 3x in Art. Physics are working hard to ensure an uplift in their outcomes by providing targeted support for those students who require it.
